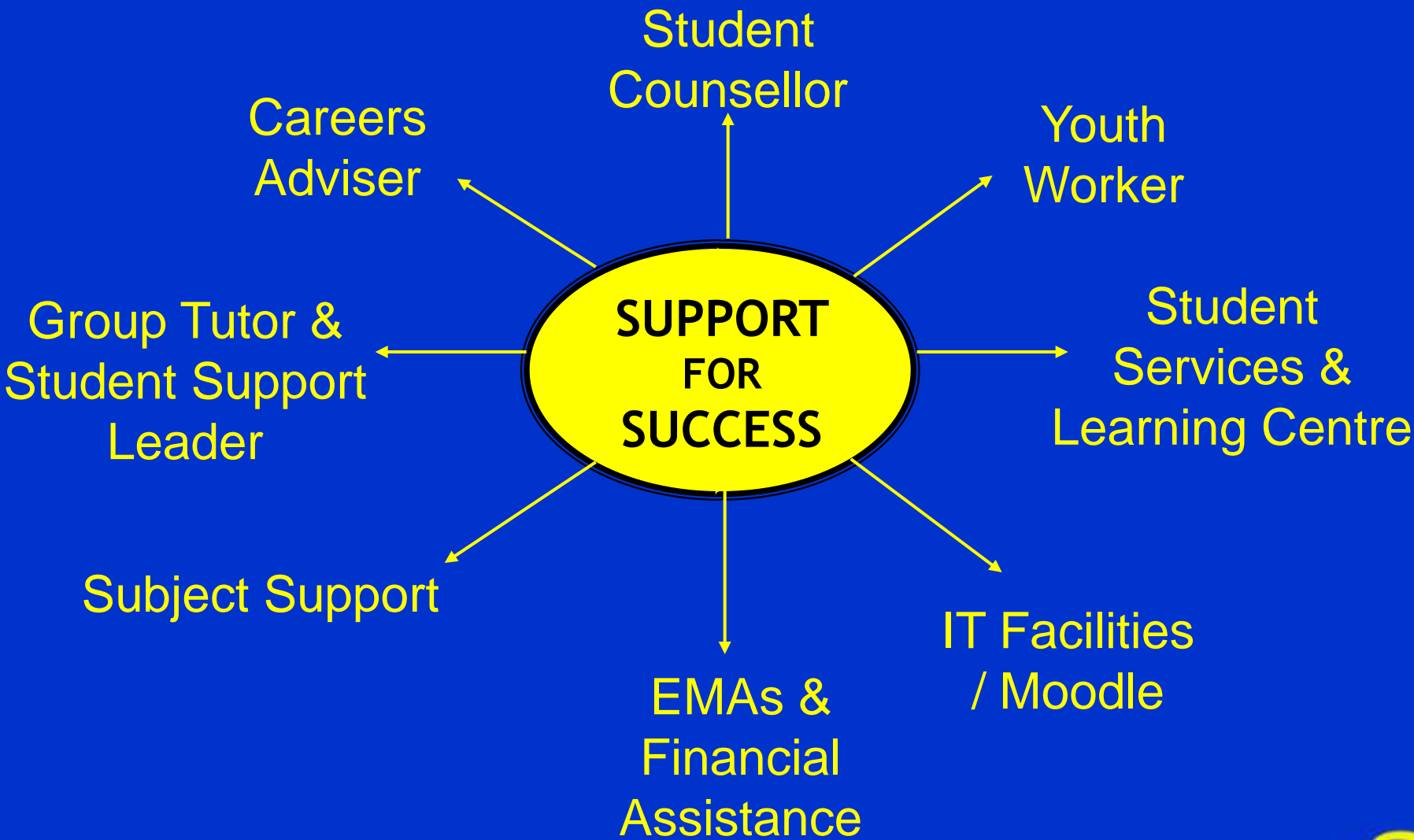

- Poor attendance - contribution to exam fee



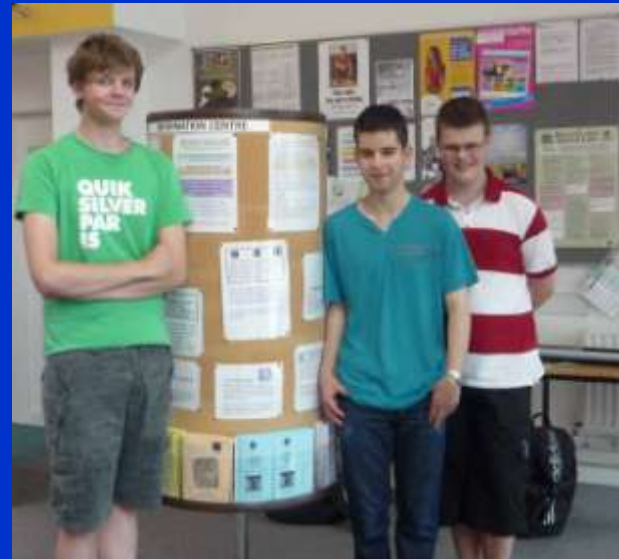
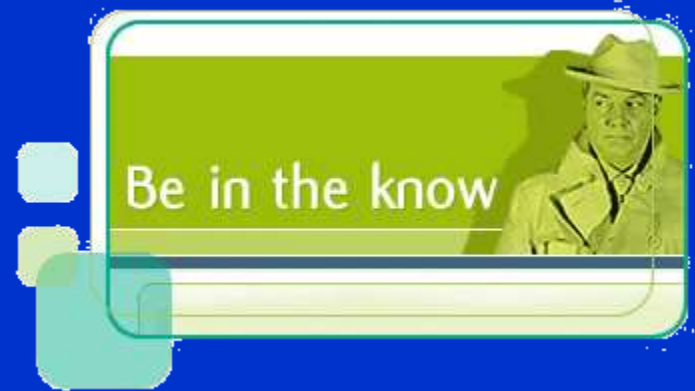
Financial Assistance
